

## Wayne County Kindergarten Questionnaire



## Background

In the spring and summer of 2019, for the sixth year, parents in Wayne County voluntarily completed a brief survey at the time they registered their child for Kindergarten. The survey was developed with input from Kindergarten teachers, school counselors and school administrators. A focus group of parents gave critical feedback on question wording and structure.

This report provides results for 376 parent surveys. Eight (8) schools participated in the surveys.
