Let's celebrate The Arc Wayne and end the summer in style!



Be sure to wear white to get the full effect of the colored powder. The first 200 participants to register will receive an Arc Wayne face gaitor.


This is a family-friendly accessible Fun Run and not an official timed race. The route is approximately 3K.




