- Bob is a 1987 Clyde-Savannah graduate currently living in Syracuse.
- Running is his first love (he ran a 2:52 at the 2001 Chicago Marathon- his best running accomplishment,) but finds it easier to cycle these days.
- 2018- His first ultra long bicycle tour across the Northern U.S. Bob biked 5833 miles in 120 days.
- 2022 - His 2nd bicycle tour- "The Great American Triple Switchback." It encompassed all 50 US capitals and Washington DC! He biked 16661 miles in 359 days- a feat which has never been done before!

On Saturday, June 10th, Bob will embark on his new journey- the "Great American Coastal Excursion!" Meet him as he arrives in Clyde at 1pm during the River Rock Music Festival at Laurville Landing. Stop by his table to greet him and learn all about his new journey!

Finger Lakes Community Action, through our RSVP program, has provided medical transportation for seniors in Wayne, Ontario and Seneca counties for many, many years.

We do this by pairing volunteer drivers with seniors *who have no other way to get to/from their appointments.*

All of this takes a lot of coordination, primarily on the phone with both the volunteer drivers and the people seeking rides.

WE NEED YOU TO HELP US MAKE THIS HAPPEN!

As an AmeriCorps Member you will:

- Be located at our office at **159 Montezuma Street in Lyons.**
- Serve a **regular schedule**, developed WITH you at YOUR convenience.
- Commit to serve a total of **900 hours through January 31, 2024.**
- Need **computer skills** with **Microsoft Word** and **Excel.**
- Receive weekly **Living Allowance totaling \$5000 for your term of service.**
 - Periodic financial incentives are also provided.
- Receive an **Education Award of \$3,447** upon completion of your 900 hours.
 - This can be used by YOU for up to 7 years, OR
 - If you are 55 or better, you can 'gift it' to a child or grandchild. THEY will have up to 10 years to use these funds.
