School and Community Leaders Aim to Transform Education across New York at Community Schools Resilience and Equity Conference at Syracuse University

May 2023

Nearly 700 educators and community leaders from Central New York and across the state participated in the **Finger Lakes Community Schools Resilience and Equity Conference** May 16 - 19 at Syracuse University.

The conference was sponsored by **Peaceful Schools** in Syracuse, and **Finger Lakes Community Schools**, an organization created to promote the community schools model of utilizing school buildings as hubs of community development. Community schools mobilize existing community assets and recruits new resources to meet student and family needs, often through out-of-school time, collaborative leadership, and community engagement.

“In a world and a time where it seems like there are lots of problems, Community Schools offers answers,” says Jay Roscup, Director of Wayne County Community Schools. The Resilience and Equity Conference featured national speakers from the U.S. Department of Education and National Center for Community Schools, representatives from the New York State Board of Regents, and regional community schools experts from CNY, Wayne County, and beyond. Sessions addressed the delivery of social and educational interventions in schools designed to mitigate implicit bias and to promote equity in school systems.

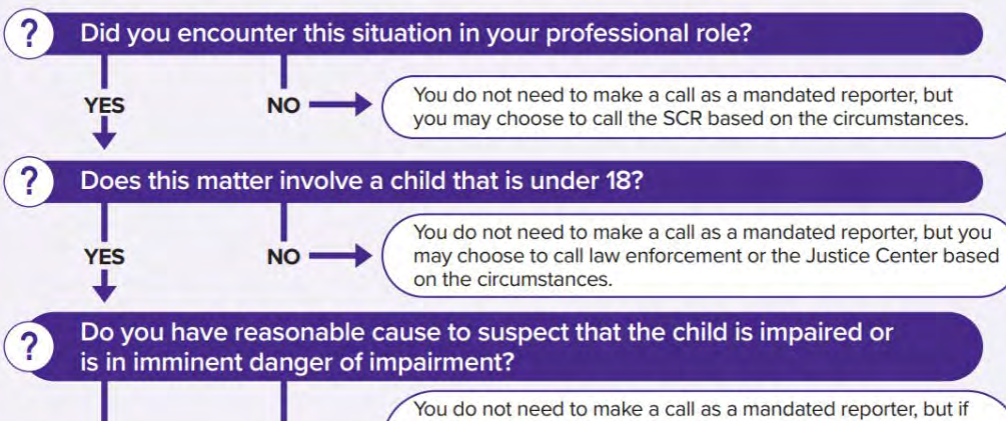

All mandated reporters are required to complete the new **OCFS Mandated Reporter Training** by April 1, 2025 to be in compliance with N.Y. Soc. Serv. Law § 413(5). The training can be accessed via the **OCFS website**, where you will be prompted to register: Mandated Reporter Training.
