Start your career in health care by becoming a Home Health Aide

**What is a Home Health Aide (HHA)?**  
HHAs provide care to people after a hospital stay or to people needing help managing an illness. Tasks include:  
- Helping people with daily activities, such as getting dressed, bathing, eating, housekeeping, and using the bathroom  
- Checking blood pressure, breathing, and pulse  
- Reminding people to take medications, and more  
Care is provided in people's homes, so most have reliable transportation.

**Are HHA jobs available?**  
Yes. These local home care agencies have immediate job openings that provide free training to become a HHA.

**Can a HHA lead to other health care jobs?**  
Yes. Working as a HHA is the first step on a career ladder that could include becoming a licensed practical nurse, registered nurse, and more.

**How much money does a HHA make?**  
**\$17.55/hour\***  
\*Earn a maximum of \$17.55/hour during training.

**Employee Benefits**  
Including mileage reimbursement and paid travel time, tuition assistance, health insurance, and vacation and sick time.

**\$1000 Bonus**  
Complete the training and pass the certification test to receive a \$250 bonus. HHAs who remain employed and in good standing will receive another \$250 after 90 days and after six months receive another \$500.

**How do I get started?**  
The first step is to apply at one of the three agencies by going to their career website (info provided on other side). To apply you must have a high school diploma or a GED.  
As part of the hiring process, there will be a background check and a career readiness workshop for you to have the opportunity to learn more about the role.  
Once you are hired, you will participate in a three-week training program and get paid during the training.  
You will need to complete 75 hours of training and pass a test to become certified in New York State.  
You will also receive mental health first aid training and obtain a certificate of completion.  
All the training and tests are conducted in English.

Rochester Regional Health East Region Workforce Development Program is offering training in becoming a Certified Nursing Assistant and a Home Health Aide. **Certified Nursing Assistants at the Newark and Clifton Spring facilities earn a starting rate of \$19.25 per hour (plus additional shift differential and incentives) and Home Health Aides earn a starting rate of \$17.60 (including during training).**

There is an upcoming ASIST training at Wayne Behavioral Health Network, 1519 Nye Rd., Lyons from 8:30-4:30 on both April 29<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>.

ASIST is a two-day intensive, interactive, and practice-dominated course designed to help caregivers recognize and review risk, and intervene to prevent the immediate risk of suicide. It is by far the most widely used, acclaimed and researched suicide intervention training workshop in the world. ASIST prepares caregivers of all kinds to provide suicide first aid interventions.

In this workshop you will have an opportunity to explore your experiences with and your attitudes about suicide. You will also have an opportunity to better understand the needs of a person at risk of suicide and learn how to use suicide first-aid to meet those needs.

15 Contact hours are available for SW and LMHC with a payment fee of \$62.24. Feel free to share this training with anyone 18 years old and up.
